Past Events & Meetings Attended:

- Discussions held with the Royal Engineers have confirmed that due to operational reasons, the next path restoration work will now commence 20 April.

Meeting held with John Pelham, the newly appointed Public Rights of Way Officer. Replacement gates for Strawberry Banks, which were stolen prior to Christmas, are now on order. He has made contact with the landowner regarding the installation of replacement stiles/gates on KH38 and has delivered two kissing gates for installation on KH55, which the landowner has agreed to install.

- BWAG are working closely with Kent Wildlife Trust to identify more landowners.
- A newsletter was emailed to over 400 members and supporters with an additional 90 hard copies sent to landowners and members. This has prompted new members to join and additional donations have been received.
